IMPORTANT CURBSIDE RECYCLING INFORMATION

All material must be at curbside by 7:00 a.m.

COMMINGLED MATERIAL

- **METAL** cans should only consist of food and pet food types. Labels may remain on and metal lids included.
- **GLASS** jars and bottles of all types and colors are acceptable. Labels may remain on and metal caps included. Plastic caps should not be included.
- **PLASTIC** bottles such as soda, juice milk jugs and detergent containers that are coded with a "1" or "2"; plastic caps should not be included.
- **EMPTY AEROSOL CANS** spray nozzle and plastic cap should not be included.
- **CLEAN ALUMINUM FOIL & TRAYS**
All commingled items must be rinsed to free them of food particles and residue. All material above should be combined together at curbside in a container/box that will be emptied and left for reuse.
Material in plastic bags will not be collected.

PAPER/CARDBOARD PULP

- **NEWSPAPER**, including inserts. May be bundled or placed in a container or box that can be emptied and left for reuse.
- **CARDBOARD** must be "non wax" cardboard and free of excessive amounts of plastic adhesive tape. Staples need not be removed. It can either be broken up and placed inside a container/cardboard box or used to contain newspaper.
- **BROWN GROCERY BAGS** should be folded and placed inside of another kraft bag or bag may be used to contain newspaper and junk mail.
- **MAGAZINES** consisting of colored, glossy periodicals and catalogs.
- **JUNK MAIL** consisting of envelopes, sweepstakes forms and office papers.
- **BULK METAL** such as stoves, ranges, bar-b-que grills, etc. placed at curbside. In order to facilitate collection, call 993-1576 no later than Friday prior to Tuesday pickup.

REFRIGERATORS, AIR CONDITIONERS, WASHER/DRYERS, ARE HANDLED SEPARATELY; CALL BY FRIDAY TO SCHEDULE PICKUP FOR THE FOLLOWING TUESDAY

NEW REGULATIONS FOR E-WASTE

DPW NOW ACCEPTS ALL E-WASTE AT THE HIGHWAY GARAGE (100 Sprain Road, Ardsley) 7am - 3pm
E-WASTE INCLUDES: COMPUTER TOWERS, PRINTERS, ELECTRONIC KITCHEN ITEMS, RADIOS, STEREOS, OLD PHONES, CRTS, TVs;
BASICALLY ALMOST ANYTHING WITH A CORD

YARD WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS IS PROHIBITED

YARD WASTE BRANCHES/BRUSH (CUT TO 4' LENGTHS & TIED), LEAVES, GRASS, CLIPPINGS PLACED IN BIODEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS OR CONTAINED IN PAILS, BEGINS ON WEDNESDAY AND CONTINUES THROUGH FRIDAY.

Important Information Regarding Leaves

The Town collects leaves beginning in October.

Leaves shall be placed at edge of property.

Avoid fines - do not pile leaves in the street or on sidewalk.

Leaves may also be placed in paper bags for weekly collection.

The town provides 15 leaf bags per household, available at Town Hall, during the months of October and November.

Landscapers must obtain a permit to dispose of leaves at the Town waste transfer facility.

Drop off household waste that cannot be set out for curbside collection or recycling.

What's Accepted:

Properly labeled household chemicals,
including:

Most Automotive Fluids - antifreeze, brake fluid, gasoline

Flammable Liquids - kerosene, butane, charcoal fluid, turpentine

Metal, Jewelry & Furniture Polishes, Wood Preservatives

Pesticides, Insecticides, Herbicides

Photographic & Swimming Pool Chemicals

Other Items, including:

Fluorescent Light Bulbs

Fire Extinguishers

Propane Tanks (2, 5, 10 & 20 lb.)

Batteries - Auto, Alkaline, Rechargeable & Button Cell

Cell Phones

Car Tires (maximum 10)

Mercury Thermometers and Thermostats

E-WASTE - Computer monitors, TV's, computer towers, accessories, printers, faxes, phones, cell phones and small appliances, i.e. toasters, blenders, radios, stereos, speakers, lamps

White Waste - washers, dryers, freezers, stoves, refrigerators

Air Conditioners

Expired or Unused Pharmaceuticals -

Both prescription and over the counter

Plastic Grocery Bags - Bring in 20 bags or more and get a free reusable shopping bag - while supplies last.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **How do I dispose of paint cans?** All paint must be either dried up using cat litter, or remaining paint can be poured onto rags to dry up; cans can be put out with trash but leave lids off.
- **How do I dispose of propane tanks?** Propane tanks should be disposed of during Westchester County Household Chemical Cleanup Days.
- **How do I dispose of construction debris?** Construction debris (including cement must be removed by a private carter or the contractor that did the work).
- **How do I dispose of Styrofoam - is it recyclable?** Styrofoam can be placed out with garbage.
- **How do I dispose of batteries - both household and car?** Regular batteries can be put out with the household garbage. Car batteries must be taken to a mechanic/gas station.
- **How do I dispose of carpet?** Carpeting must be cut and tied up; then placed out with the garbage.
- **How do I dispose of metal items such as metal desks, garage doors/tracks?** These items can be placed out with white metal pickup. Garage door tracks should be cut down to 4 foot lengths or less.
